



Starting from a jazz trio line up, **K12** is a powerful and highly expressive project with a clear concept: the music around an unknown planet (K12) and all the universes that unfolds from it. **Gori Matas** (piano), **Marko Lohikari** (bass) and **Teo Salvà** (drums) share a profound interplay that makes possible **K12** sound; they efficiently dance with tunes that embrace sharp melodies, bright chords, wild improvisation and sensitive playing, creating an ever interesting musical experience and a powerful live performance often described as a "journey" by the audience. From their beginnings in 2019, **K12** has been a highly creative trio, releasing four albums until now and playing in many festivals around the Balearic Islands and showcases in mainland Spain and France. Winners of **Ciutat de Palma** music awards for their second album **Two Years in K12**, the three friends never stop exploring the limitless forms of improvised music, using influences like pop, rock, classical and contemporary to shape their tunes.



GORI MATAS (Mallorca 1988)
A highly creative, versatile pianist with a long career in the Balearic Islands music scene. He has worked as a composer in theatre and TV shows, as well as a live performance musician with international artists such as Salvador Sobral, Emily Braden or Aina Zanoquera, with whom he shares the project Two Little Rooms.



MARKO LOHIKARI (Upsala 1979)
With a unique, sensible approach to bass playing, Marko is a high profile musician trained at the prestigious Sibelius Academy (Helsinki). Among others he has worked with Teemu Viinikainen, Alexi Tuomarila, Jussi Kannaste, Perico Sambeat, Marco Mezquida Jorge Rossy, Albert Sanz, Marc Miralta and Shai Maestro.



TEO SALVÀ (Mallorca 1987)
He is one of the main drummers in the Mallorcan jazz scene. He has played with international musicians such as Hanna Paulsberg, Pawel Tomaszewski, Odd Steinar, Jasper Blom, Reinier Baas and Jorge Pardo. He is also winner of several jazz awards (Unesco Interjazz 2015, Virtual Jazz Contest (2017), Ciutat de Palma 2021 and 2022).

K12 has performed in venues and festivals such as **Auditòrium de Palma** (2020, 2024), **Casa Del Poble de Formentera** (2020), **Palma Jazz** (2024), **Jazz & Mas Fest** (2025), **Inca Jazz** (2025), **Jazz Lounge** (2024, 2025), **Robadors 23** (2025).

The trio has also showcased at **Fira B!** (Mallorca, 2019, 2023, 2025), **Jazz I am** (Barcelona, 2024) and **Jazzebre Occijazz** (Perpignan, 2025).
